



Lesson No. 4 : Implementing CSS

There are 4 ways of implementing CSS :

- Declare inline,
- embed into the head of your document,
- link to an external CSS file,
- *import* a CSS file.

Inline CSS

Style is applied to the current element. Instead of defining the style once, then applying the style against all instances of an element, you only apply the style to the instance you want the style to apply to.

Exercise No. 3

Open Notepad and save the file as *inlineCSS.html.*

1. Type the following HTML code in Notepad.

```
<html>
<head>
<title> Inline CSS </title>
</head>
<body>
<h1 style= "color:green;"> This is Inline CSS . </h1>
</body>
</html>
```

2. Close the Notepad file and open it in Internet Explorer. It will look as shown in the following window.
